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NETIQUETTE RULES

Netiquette is short for “internet etiquette.” Just as etiquette is a code of polite behaviour in society, netiquette is a code or set of rules for good and acceptable online behaviour. Our online communication will include emails, learning management systems and social networking sites, hence it is important to behave properly and write politely to everyone.

1 GENERAL EXPECTATIONS

We respect the learning environment at all times.

We demonstrate self-respect and respect for others at all times.

We enter the learning environment wearing proper attire.

We bring our supplies daily. We abide by the established rules of the host/teacher.

2 DRESS CODE

The school's uniform is required for all online classes.

You may wear the tie of the previous year.

Your hair must be properly groomed.

No braids are allowed.

P. E. gear can be worn only on the days scheduled for Physical Education classes.

3 ARRIVAL TO CLASS

- Ensure that you are on time for each class (inclusion of registration).
- Gather all materials needed for class.
- Enter the virtual classroom with mics on mute.
- You may enter the virtual classroom with your video camera on.
- Please type your first name upon arrival so the teacher can take the register.
- Be fully dressed before entering the virtual classroom.

4 DURING CLASS

- Keep your mics on mute. Listen and follow directions.
- Wait to be acknowledged before you speak.
- Refrain from unnecessary talk and texting in the chat space.
- Refrain from grooming self during virtual classes.
- Refrain from eating, drinking and chewing gum during virtual class.
- Refrain from engaging in disruptive behaviours.

Absolutely no profanity allowed.

- Be respectful of everyone in the classroom. Be mindful of what you type or post in the chat.
- Use the screen tabs or present information only when you are authorized by the teacher (present only what is asked by the teacher).
- Do not invite students from other schools to your sessions.

5 END OF CLASS

- The teacher dismisses you, not the time
- Sign out when the teacher indicates that you should.
- Leave the room when the class has ended. The space is not for your personal activities.
